Breed Appreciation Days (BAD) will be a mandatory requirement for all judges wishing to judge English Setters from the new Level 2, or judges wishing to progress from Level 1 to Level 2. The above link to the JCF will assist you with your judging level, but please do not hesitate to contact me if you need any further advice.

The morning session will consist of an introduction to the English Setter and the Kennel Club Breed Standard which is an essential part of the criteria in awarding CC's in the breed, followed by the opportunity for individuals to examine exhibits assisted by CC judges. The afternoon will consist of the Multiple Choice Exam (MCE) on the Kennel Club Breed Standard for the English Setter.

Anyone can apply to attend the BAD, but only judges that have undertaken the following Kennel Club education seminars are eligible to take the multiple-choice Breed Standard Exam (MCE).

- To have passed the Rules & Regulations of a Dog Show Judge
- To have Passed the Points of the Dog Assessment
- To have attended a Conformation & Movement Seminar
